Bath Mat – Product Care FAQs





How do I clean my Badeloft Bath Mat?

The Bath Mat is made with fast-drying diatomaceous earth to help prevent mold. Still, it needs airflow to dry fully. Use the included non-slip pad to slightly elevate it and let it dry between uses. If overly saturated, lean it against a wall until it returns to its light color.

Cleaning tips:

- Use included sandpaper for light scuffs.
- For tough stains, apply diluted bleach or hydrogen peroxide.

How do I prevent staining?

The natural, light-colored material can stain from dirt or dark liquids.

To avoid this:

- Only step on with clean feet.
- Wipe spills immediately.
- Wet sand with 150-grit sandpaper for minor marks.

Can I use it on marble?

We don't recommend using the Bath Mat on marble or natural stone surfaces, as they're porous and may stain.

Why are there white spots on my Slate mat?

White specks are naturally occurring from the diatomaceous earth and are part of the product's makeup.

How do I prevent breakage?

While durable, the mat can crack under force. Always use the foam pad underneath to evenly disperse weight and avoid impact.

What's the foam pad for?

Place it under the mat to reduce slipping and absorb shock.
